Make it pink

Château La Gordonne Rosé, Vérité du Terroir, Côtes de Provence, France, 201525.00

It has a generous bouquet with aromas of ripe red fruits, such as fresh strawberry, and notes of blackcurrant and violet. The palate again shows red fruit but this time with grapefruit and other citrus; there's a touch of richness on the finish.

Wicked Lady White Zinfandel, California, USA, 201536.00

This wine is a salmon-pink colour and shows red fruits on the rich, juicy palate.



White Wines

Make It Classic

- Solandia Grillo, Terre Siciliane, Sicilia, Italy, 2016/1725.00**
Straw-yellow in colour with youthful green highlights. The bouquet shows ripe yellow peach and mango with notes of almond and camomile.
- Granfort Chardonnay, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2016/1728.00**
A soft, green apple scented Chardonnay which demonstrates its unoaked nature with plenty of fruit on the palate.
- The Manor Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa, 201829.00**
Fresh and crisp with aromas of pineapple, peach and guava; well balanced with delicate layers of ripe fruit on the finish.
- Côte Lavande, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2016/17 31.00**
Flavours of fresh grapefruit are prevalent, whilst the wine is balanced by a crisp acidity, ending with a long finish.
- Pinot Grigio Trentino L'Aristocratico, Trentino, Italy, 2017/1834.00**
This fine example of the popular Pinot Grigio is made using fruit sourced from high altitude vineyards in the foothills of the Alps.
- Luis Felipe Edwards Gran Reserva Sauvignon Blanc, Leyda Valley, Chile, 2017/1834.00**
This Sauvignon Blanc is fresh and full-flavoured with an edgy acidity and some mineral notes. Bright and solid, this wine is rich with lush flavours of lime, grapefruit, greengage, gooseberry, green fig and a hint of green bell pepper with a long and attractive finish.
- Waipara Hills Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2016/1737.00**
A generous and lifted style, showing powerful aromas of melon, nettle and snow pea; the palate bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit and melon notes, the fruit carrying through to the aromatic finish.
- Gavi di Gavi, Enrico Serafino, Piemonte, Italy, 2016/739.00**
Unoaked, the wine spends a little time on its lees to develop a richer mouth-feel. Pale straw-yellow, the wine shows floral and citrus aromas, with a minerally, dry palate.
- Soellner Wogenrain Grüner Veltliner, Wagram, Austria, 201642.00**
The grapes are hand-picked, and the juice is slowly fermented in stainless steel tanks. Maturation takes place for a short time in oak casks. After the second racking, the Wogenrain is kept in tank until the following spring in order to retain freshness and fruit purity.
- Paco & Lola Albarino, Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain, 2016/1747.00**
The palate is clean and textured with seductive exotic notes of pineapple and mango intermingled with refreshing citrus flavours amplified by minerally accents. The fruit is grown in the Val do Salnes sub-region, in sustainably managed vineyards planted on a mixture of granitic, sandy and loam soils.
- Château du Seuil, Graves Blanc, Bordeaux, France, 2015/1647.00**
A wine with great depth and ageing potential in the classic mould of a top Graves yet exhibiting a modern feel; bouquet of honey and citrus fruits, floral aromas from the vibrant Sauvignon Blanc, with a classic Graves minerality on the palate. Elegant, citrus dominated style with perfect weight.
- Chablis, Vignerons de Chablis, Burgundy, France, 2016/1753.00**
Fresh, lively wine with a citrus and white blossom character backed by a finish tinged with minerality. The Chardonnay grapes are harvested at the optimum moment, usually quite late due to Chablis' cool climate, and cool fermented in stainless steel prior to a period of rest and integration before bottling.



Make It Interesting

- Quinta das Arcas Arca Nova Branco Vinho Verde, Portugal, 2016/1727.00**
A blend of mainly Loureiro and Arinto with a small amount of Trajadura, grown in the relatively cool climate of northern Portugal. Each of the varieties brings something different to the blend; Loureiro has a fresh, herbal outlook, Arinto provides citrus fruit and notes of stone-fruit, whilst Trajadura brings apple, pear and hints of peach.
- Vine Trail Viognier, Rapel Valley, Chile, 2017/1830.00**
Made from 100% Viognier, this wine shows notes of peach, apricot, pear and white blossom, balanced with a citrus acidity on the palate.
- Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Trambusti, Toscana, Italy, 2015/1632.00**
Tuscany's most celebrated white DOCG. Made using only Vernaccia grapes harvested from the hillsides surrounding the historic town of San Gimignano. Unoaked, it shows ripe apple fruit and peach with some floral notes and a bitter twist to the finish.
- Anjou Chenin Blanc, Signature du Cl ray, Sauvion, Loire Valley, France, 2015/1633.00**
The Chenin Blanc grapes for this wine are sourced from vineyards south of the town of Angers, about 20% of the blend is barrel-fermented. Just off-dry, the wine shows lemon and white flower aromas on the nose and a touch of acacia honey on the finish.
- Scala Ciro DOC Bianco, Puglia, Italy, 201634.00**
Clear, straw-coloured yellow, elegant and bright with scents of white flowers. Dry, cool and tasty, well balanced with a refined after taste.
- Veralda Malvazija Prestige, Istria, Croatia, 2015/1638.00**
Bright yellow in colour with slight greenish reflections. Floral notes of elderberry and honey with a hint of fruitiness and pineapple. On the palate, baked apples with notes of citrus and passion fruit and a lively, zesty finish.
- Fritz Hasselbach Fritz's Riesling, Rheinhessen, Germany, 201642.00**
Good Rheinhessen Rieslings, such as this fine example from the Gunderloch estate based in Nackenheim, show a touch more softness than perhaps Mosel or Rheingau wines. This makes them very user-friendly and are also very flexible with food. Off-dry, with a balancing acidity, notes of melon and lime and a touch of spritz.
- Nederburg The Anchorman Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa, 2016/1745.00**
Dry, mineral and well-structured, it shows ripe apricot, orange with hints of raisin, spice and floral notes.
- Nederburg The Beautiful Lady Gewurztraminer, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2016/1746.00**
The wine is rich, yet the sweetness is well tempered by the acidity; shows pronounced aromas of rose, lychee and pineapple.



Make It Special

- Chablis 1er Cru, Domiane Des Marnanies, Burgundy, France, 201660.00**
A classic, complex premier cru Chablis. This wine has aromas and flavours of citrus fruit intertwined with notes of gunflint.
- Bastianich, Vespa Bianco, Friuli, Italy, 201370.00**
A tightly wound balance of minerality and citrus, clover honey and mature pear. This wine can be further aged up to 7-10 years after the vintage.
- Cervaro Della Sala Antinori, Umbria, Italy, 201575.00**
Toasted aromas along with notes of citrus and tropical fruit and lightly buttery sensations. Fresh and savoury on the palate.
- Terlato Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, 201390.00**
Barrel-fermented and aged for nine months in French oak barrels (20% new). Shows apple pie spices, cinnamon and clove, Granny Smith apple, apricot and white peach; the palate is long with a refined, cool climate. A refreshing finish.



Red Wines

Make It Classic

- Solandia Nero d'Avola, Terre Siciliane, Sicilia, Italy, 201625.00**
Nero d'Avola is a grape variety native to Sicily. With its dark, ripe berried fruit and a hint of liquorice and vanilla spice, it shows a similarity in style to Shiraz.
- Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France, South of France, 201729.00**
The smooth, velvety palate shows cherry and blueberry flavours backed with a hint of sweet oak spice.
- The Manor Shiraz, Western Cape, South Africa, 201829.00**
An abundance of prune, plum and cherry with pencil shaving and oak spice aromas is met on the palate by flavours of ripe plum, cherry and dark chocolate.
- Luis Felipe Edwards Gran Reserva Merlot, Colchagua Valley, Chile, 201633.00**
Big and bold, aged for about a year in a mixture of new and second-use French oak barrels, it is absolutely packed to bursting point with dark plum, cassis, bramble fruits, blueberry and winter spice.
- Côtes du Rhone-Villages, Plan de Dieu, Ogier, Rhone Valley, France, 2015.....34.00**
A Grenache and Syrah blend that shows notes of red fruit and soft spice. Well-balanced with silky tannins, again red fruit is dominant with a touch of pepper-spice and cocoa on the finish.
- Côte Lavande, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2016/17 31.00**
A full-bodied wine with a divulge of black fruit flavours on the palate. There is a perfect balance between acidity and tannins and a gentle, soft finish.
- Barbera D'Asti , Enrico Serafino, Piedimont, Italy, 201334.00**
It was aged for about six months in large oak barrels to soften and integrate the tannins.
- Vina Real Rioja Crianza, Rioja, Spain, 201337.00**
Ripe and richly fruity wine with rich aromas of fruit cake and spice, smooth and supple in the mouth with perfectly integrated oak, a rounded silky texture and smooth tannins, all supported by a lovely weight of fruit.
- The Colonial Esate Explorateur Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia, 201539.00**
The Explorateur Shiraz offers sweet aromas of blackberries, white pepper, liquorice and graphite. Full-bodied, powerful and rich.
- Salentein Barrel Selection Malbec, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina, 2016/1745.00**
Deep red-purple coloured wine; very intense nose with notes of ripe blackberry, blueberry and redcurrant, with subtle hints of violet. The silky palate has a crisp, balancing acidity which shows the fruit and floral notes backed by vanilla on the lingering finish. Barrel-aged for about a year in a mixture of new and seasoned French oak barrels prior to bottling.



Make It Interesting

- Bardolino Classico, Bolla, Veneto, Italy, 2015** **32.00**
Cool-fermented to conserve the maximum fruit flavours and aromas; typically light-bodied with a fresh, fruity character.
- Pablo Old Vine Garnacha, Calatayud, Arago, Spain, 2016/17** **32.00**
The grapes for this richly flavoured wine were hand-harvested from bush-trained vines, many of which are about 100 years old, grown on vineyards up to 800 metres above sea level. Shows ripe blueberry, blackberry and cherry fruit, backed by a refreshing juicy finish.
- Veramonte Carmenere Reserva, Colchagua Valley, Chile, 2016/17** **35.00**
Purple with red highlights; shows notes of raspberry and cherry on the nose, ripe blue and black fruits being added on the medium-bodied palate. Spicy notes develop towards finish, some from the small amount of oak ageing and some from the grape itself.
- Brouilly Domaine des Dames de la Roche, Jean Loron, Burgundy, France, 2014** **37.00**
Classically vibrant summer fruit bouquet with a typically light, ripe, juicy palate.
- Domaine Du Seuil, Cadillac Cotes de Bordeaux, Bordeaux, France, 2015** **39.00**
Sean and Nicola Allison of Château du Seuil in Graves have additional vineyard holdings on the opposite side of the River Garonne. The blend is 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot and 5% Cabernet France, part of the wine is aged for up to nine months in oak barrels. Most vineyard plots are now certified as organic.
- Rocca di Frassinello Rigogolo, Toscana, Italy, 2010** **42.00**
Aromas and flavours of berries, plums, liquorice and warm spice. A velvety mouthfeel and generous finish.
- Glatzer Blaufrankisch Reserve, Carnunum, Austria, 2014** **44.00**
Robust, spicy red with a firm tannin structure and aromas of blackberries and violets, paired with an elegant herbal note.
- Primus Carmenere, Colchagua Valley, Casa Blanca Valley, Chile, 2015** **43.00**
Aged for a year in French oak barrels, 25% of which are new, it shows plum and blackberry mingling with exotic spice and dried fig. James Suckling scored the 2013 at 93 points and stated 'Now one of the best Carmenères in Chile'.
- Vavasour Pinot Noir, Awatere Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2014/16** **44.00**
A luscious and aromatic wine, which features black cherry, plum and anise spice; the finish is elegant, long and velvety.
- Nederburg HH Motorcycle, Western Cape, South Africa, 2015** **45.00**
A blend of Shiraz, Carignan, Grenache, Shiraz, Mourvèdre and Cinsault (31%, 31%, 18%, 11% and 9% respectively) all hand-harvested. Fermented in open-topped tanks, the wine was matured in barrels, some French oak and none new, for about two years prior to bottling. Spicy hedgerow fruit on the nose, the palate is rich and intense with silky tannins.
- Domaine de Font-Sane Gigondas, Rhone, France, 2013** **50.00**
This deep, full-bodied red wine has delicious flavours of black fruits and warm spices.
- Crozes Hermitage Rouge Les Jalets Paul Jaboulet Aine, Rhone, France, 2015** **50.00**
This wine has aromas and flavours of fresh red berries, followed by notes of liquorice and black pepper. A well-balanced wine with a long peppery finish.
- Rolland & Gal Ribera del Duero, Castilla - Leon, Spain, 2014** **50.00**
The wine is aged in French oak barrels for about 10 months before final blending; about 15% of the blend is Merlot, which adds colour and flavour complexity. Aromas of cinnamon, lavender, and black cherry lead to a smooth-textured, concentrated and fleshy palate that shows elegance and silky tannins.



Make It Special

- Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Nicolis, Italy, 201070.00**
This is a big rich wine with deep concentrated dried fruit, chocolate, spice and plum flavours. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity balance the intensity of flavour.
- Barolo Castiglione, Viette, Piedimont, Italy, 201290.00**
Stweet red berries, freshly cut flowers, spices and mint are some of the many notes that grace the palate in a young Barolo with extraordinary finesse.
- Frog's Leap, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California, 201390.00**
From the heart of the Rutherford Bench, this estate-grown wine is a classic version of restraint and elegance, structured in dusty tannin with bursts of cedar, tomato leaf and cassis. Cabernet Franc makes up 8% of the blend, with 3% Merlot.
- Châteauneuf du Pape, Château de Beaucastel, Rhone, France, 2009120.00**
This vintage is very bright ruby in appearance; a beautiful wine with power intense aromas of black fruit and chocolate. A vibrant wine with great balance.
- Morey-St-Denis 1er Cru Chaffots, Burgundy, France, 2013130.00**
Chaffots sits just above Grand Cru Clos de la Roche on the very rocky terrain with not much top soil. There are some nice whole bunch aromatics going on here and more flesh than a Chaffots sometimes shows at this stage. If this continues to go in the right direction, it could be a little cracker.
- Catena Zapata, Atena Zapata, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2010140.00**
Packed with generous flavours of ripe red fruit and spices, this is a vibrant, full bodied intense Malbec. This vineyard (at 1,600 metres above sea level is one of the highest in the Uco Valley) delivers intense freshness and crisp acidity.
- Château Malescot St Exupéry, Bordeaux, France, 2004140.00**
Cassis, pencil shavings, forest floor, cedar and touch of leather. Texture is supple, tannins firm. Quite elegant.
- Château Lagrange St Julien, Bordeaux, France, 2005150.00**
Concentrated, structured, tannic, firm and built to age, this powerful, masculine St Julien is still young. Time and effort were needed before the earthy, coffee, blackberry, fresh herb and tobacco personality began to emerge. This demands at least 5-8 years in the cellar for everything to come together.
