## Make it Pink

**Santa Rita Rosé, Central Valley, Chile, 2018 .....26.00**  
Intensive, shining raspberry-coloured with violet reflexes. Wonderfully fruity notes of sour cherries, ripe plums and some wild fruits (raspberries). At the palate a refreshing type with a good body and a very intensive fruit.

**Côtes de Provence Rosé, Vérité du Terroir, Château La Gondonne, France, 2018 .....35.00**  
Made from the classic Provence rosé blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault. It has a generous bouquet with aromas of ripe red fruits, such as fresh strawberry, and notes of blackcurrant and violet. The palate again shows red fruit but this time with grapefruit and other citrus, there's a touch of richness on the finish.

**Wicked Lady White Zinfandel, California, USA, 2017 .....36.00**  
A lovely bouquet of fresh strawberries and ripe raspberries. This is rosé best enjoyed very cold on a warm summer day.



## White Wines

### Make It Classic

- Solandia Grillo, Terre Siciliane, Sicilia, Italy, 2018** .....**26.00**  
Straw-yellow in colour with youthful green highlights. The bouquet shows ripe yellow peach and mango with notes of almond and camomile.
- Berri Estates Unoaked Chardonnay, South Eastern Australia, 2017** .....**28.00**  
The grapes for the fresh, lemony Chardonnay are fermented and matured in stainless steel with no oak contact. The aim is to retain the fresh varietal fruit, crisp, ripe acidity and weight to produce a classic Chardonnay.
- Nederburg The Manor, Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa, 2018** .....**30.00**  
Fresh and crisp with aromas of pineapple, peach and guava. Well balanced with delicate layers of ripe fruit on the finish.
- Solstice Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, Veneto, Italy, 2018** ..... **31.00**  
Fresh, crisp with subtle notes of citrus and pear fruit.
- Picpoul de Pinet, Petite Ronde, France, 2018** ..... **32.00**  
The wine shows a good level of freshness for a wine from such a warm climate, with a citrusy and stone fruit character highlighted with floral notes.
- Arca Nova Vino Verde, Portugale, 2017/18**.....**33.00**  
Fruity and fresh with a light body, it shows green apple and a soft minerality with a touch of spritz on the finish.
- Undurraga Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile, 201**.....**33.00**  
A generous and lifted style, showing powerful aromas of melon, nettle and snow pea; the palate bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit and melon notes, the fruit carrying through to the aromatic finish.
- Rioja Blanco, Barrel Fermented, Viña Real, Rioja, Spain, 2017** .....**35.00**  
Beautifully balanced and quite delicious with pure, floral and citrus aromas leading into a fat rounded, creamy, rich palate. This is balanced by a clean cut of grapefruit acidity and subtle toasty and biscuit flavours from being fermented in new American oak barrels and ageing on the lees.
- Vidal Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2018** .....**37.00**  
Selected from the Awatere and Wairau Valleys in Marlborough, New Zealand's premier Sauvignon Blanc growing region. Cool fermented in stainless steel. Classic gooseberry and passion fruit aromas mingled with a crisp grassy flavour.
- Saira Albariño Costers del Segre, Raimat, Catalunya, Spain, 2018** .....**38.00**  
The fashionable Albariño grape variety does not always have to come from the Rías Baixas region. Here in the high altitude vineyards of Costers del Segre it does well. Shows delicate aromas of citrus, dried flowers and spice with a hint of sweet vanilla and dried fruit, the palate is well-rounded and the finish citrusy and refreshing.
- Weingut Winter Riseling Trocken, Rheinhessen, Germany, 2016** .....**39.00**  
The nose shows apple and citrus, the palate shows just a touch of richness but finishes dry with a hint of minerality.
- Soellner Wogenrain Grüner Veltline, Wagram, Austria, 2016**.....**42.00**  
The grapes are hand picked and the juice is slowly fermented in stainless steel tanks. Maturation takes place for a short time in oak casks. After a second racking, the Wogenrain is kept in a tank until the following spring in order to retain freshness and fruit purity.



**Serafino Gavi de Gavi, Piedmont, Italy, 2018 ..... 42.00**

Made from Cortese grapes grown in the historical part of the Gavi village area in the heart of the appellation and from the best vineyards. It's one of the most successful and appreciated wines from Piedmonte. Unoaked, the wine spends a little time on its lees to develop a richer mouth-feel. The wine has a beautiful minerality and acidity with a citrus and floral bouquet.

**Jean Moreau Chablis, France, 2015 ..... 53.00**

Bone-dry white Burgundy from Chablis' most famous house. Classic Chablis flintiness with no oak ageing.

**Make It Interesting**

**Vine Trail Gewürztraminer, Rapel Valley, Chile, 2018 ..... 29.00**

A dry Gewürztraminer, with just a touch of richness, well-balanced showing classic notes of orange blossom, lychee and rose followed by a fresh finish.

**Nederburg The Manor Sauvignon Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa, 2018 ..... 30.00**

Only Sauvignon Blanc grapes from vineyards in Darling, Paarl and Philadelphia are used in the production of this zesty wine with grassy, asparagus and tropical fruit flavours. No oak is employed and only a few days of lees ageing is allowed to keep the wine's fresh character.

**Elevé Marsanne-Viognier, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2018 ..... 30.00**

Two Rhône varieties completely at home in the warm d'Oc region of southern France, unoaked, the wine shows a fresh, floral character with notes of peach, the finish is soft and slightly spicy.

**Cataratto Cusumano, Sicily, Italy, 2017 ..... 33.00**

Fresh, crisp white with a medium structure and mild acidity. Citrus fruit, lemon zest and citrus blossoms on the nose, along with hint of tropical fruits, herbs and sweet spices. Lovely minerality on the finish.

**Strofilia White Dot Moschofilero-Roditis Dry White, Peloponnese, Greece, 2017 ..... 34.00**

Pale yellow with aromas of rose petals, lemon blossom and citrus, the palate is characterised by fresh aromatic fruit, backed by a soft round textured finish.

**Anjou Chenin Blanc, Signature du Cleray, Sauvion, Loire, France, 2015 ..... 34.00**

The Chenin Blanc grapes for this wine are sourced from vineyards south of the town of Angers, about 20% of the blend is barrel fermented. Just off-dry, the wine shows lemon and white flower aromas on the nose and a touch of acacia honey on the finish.

**Red Knot Chardonnay, McLaren Vale, Australia, 2016 ..... 36.00**

Light straw with tints of green. Lemon rind, mandarin and honeydew melon primary aromas are entwined with creamy cashew notes. A medium-bodied wine with flavours of peach and lime, a deliciously textured palate and a long, fresh, zesty finish. A small portion of Sémillon was included in the blend for added complexity and structure.

**Feudi Salentini 125 Malvasia del Salento, Puglia, Italy, 2016 ..... 37.00**

Fashioned from hand-harvested Malvasia grapes, from vineyards around Taranto, about half way up the 'heel' of Italy. The grapes are fermented at low temperatures after a 24 hour maceration and the finished wine is aged in stainless steel tanks to integrate the flavours. Straw-yellow with golden hints, it shows tropical and grapey fruit flavours, with notes of almond, apricot and blossom. The palate is off-dry with honeyed fruit and a fresh finish.

**Vermentino di Sardegna, La Cala, Sella & Mosca, Sardinia, Italy, 2017 ..... 38.00**

Produced from 100% Vermentino, a grape variety that has been grown on the island of Sardinia for hundreds of years and is at home in the warm Mediterranean climate. Early harvesting of some of the grapes and drying them in the sun helps increase the concentration of flavours. Unoaked, the wine shows typical aromatic herb and lemon zest notes on the light and refreshing finish.



**Veralada Malvazija Prestige, Istria, Croatia, 2016 .....38.00**  
Golden in colour it has aromas of honey and baked apple, with a ripeness on the palate with notes of citrus and passion fruit and a lively, zesty finish.

**Nederburg The Anchorman Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa, 2017 ..... 45.00**  
The fruit was fermented by a number of methods including in stainless steel, second-use oak barrels and large oak vats. A portion also underwent a 'carbonic maceration' fermentation usually reserved for light red wines, to produce an overtly fruity wine. The components were lees-aged for about nine months prior to blending. Dry, minerally and well-structured, it shows ripe apricot, orange with hints of raisin, spice and floral notes.

**Nederburg The Beautiful Lady Gewürztraminer, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2016 .....47.00**  
Hand-harvested fruit was gently pressed and skin contact allowed for 12 hours to concentrate the aromatic flavours. With 22g/l of residual sugar, the wine is rich, yet the sweetness is well tempered by the acidity, shows pronounced aromas of rose, lychee and pineapple.

**Big Max Sauvignon Blanc, Napa, California, USA, 2017 .....50.00**  
Named after the last spotted brown bear in Northern California on the now Maxville vineyard site. 20% of the blend is fermented in 1 year old French oak with the remainder in stainless steel. The result is flavours of melon and white peach with bright acidity, and gorgeous citrus and floral notes.

### **Make It Special**

**Chablis 1er Cru, Domiane Des Marnanies, Burgundy, France, 2017 .....60.00**  
A classic, complex premier cru Chablis. This wine has aromas and flavours of citrus fruit intertwined with notes of gunflint.

**Bastianich, Vespa Bianco, Friuli, Italy, 2013 .....70.00**  
A tightly wound balance of minerality and citrus, clover honey and mature pear. This wine can be further aged up to 7-10 years after the vintage.

**Cervaro Della Sala Antinori, Umbria, Italy, 2015 .....75.00**  
Toasted aromas along with notes of citrus and tropical fruit and lightly buttery sensations. Fresh and savoury on the palate.

**Terlato Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, 2013 .....90.00**  
Barrel-fermented and aged for nine months in French oak barrels (20% new). Shows apple pie spices, cinnamon and clove, Granny Smith apple, apricot and white peach; the palate is long with a refined, cool climate. A refreshing finish.



## Red Wines

### Make It Classic

- Solandia Nero d'Avola, Terre Siciliane, Sicilia, Italy, 2017 .....26.00**  
Nero d'Avola is a grape variety native to Sicily. With its dark, ripe berried fruit and a hint of liquorice and vanilla spice, it shows a similarity in style to Shiraz.
- Santa Rita 8km Merlot, Central Valley, Chile, 2018 .....28.00**  
Sourced from a number of different vineyards from the Central Valley to ensure the blend of Merlot grapes has the perfect balance of concentrated fruit, tannin and acidity. Plums and blackberries dominate this wine, with subtle spicy and vanilla notes that come from the interaction with French and American oak.
- The Manor Shiraz, Western Cape, South Africa, 2017/18 .....30.00**  
An abundance of prune, plum and cherry with pencil shaving and oak spice aromas is met on the palate by flavours of plum, cherry and dark chocolate.
- Nederburg The Manor, Cabernet Sauvignon, Western Cape, South Africa, 2017.....30.00**  
Grapes are sourced from Paarl and Wellington vineyards in the Western Cape, planted on granitic soils with southerly facing slopes. Upon completion of the malolactic fermentation, the wine is matured in oak for a period of approximately 12 months. Shows an abundance of ripe berry and dark chocolate aromas with nuances of oak in the background, ripe fruit and delicate oak spice flavours, firm tannins and a lingering finish.
- Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France, France, 2018 ..... 31.00**  
The Pinot Noir grapes come from vineyards located in the south-west of Languedoc Roussillon, close to the Pyrénées mountains. The smooth, velvety palate shows cherry and blueberry flavours backed with a hint of sweet oak spice.
- Bolla Bardolino Classico, Veneto, Italy, 2017 .....32.00**  
From vineyards on the shores of Lake Garda, close to Verona. Made using the traditional mix of Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes, cool-fermented to conserve the maximum fruit flavours and aromas, typically light-bodied with a fresh, fruity character.
- Merlot Cusumano, Sicily, Italy, 2017 .....33.00**  
Dark, violet-red in colour, this Merlot is soft and silky on the palate, leaving warm flavours of plums, wild berries and liquorice.
- Valdubón Tempranillo, Ribera del Duero, Spain, 2017 .....33.00**  
Deep, cherry red in colour, ripe strawberry and plum aromas with fine notes of coconut and vanilla from the oak. The palate is smooth with fresh red berries and good body.
- Château Montcabrier, Bordeaux Supérieur, Bordeaux, France, 2017.....34.00**  
Under the ownership of the Milhade family, this wine shows single vineyard characteristics at an affordable price, a good quality wine that provides classic claret flavours. The blend is dominated by Merlot, Cabernet France making up most of the balance.
- Serafino Barbera d'Asti, Piedmont, Italy, 2016 .....34.00**  
Barbera harvested from the hills, in the central region of Piemonte, around the town of Asti, is employed to make this ruby-red, fresh and red-fruited wine. It was aged for about six months in large oak barrels to soften and integrate the tannins.
- Côtes du Rhone-Villages, Plan de Dieu, Ogier, Rhone Valley, France, 2017 .....35.00**  
A Grenache and Syrah blend that shows notes of red fruit and soft spice. Well balanced with silky tannins, again red fruit is dominant with a touch of pepper-spice and cocoa on the finish.



**Vina Pomal Centenario Crianza, Rioja, Spain, 2016 .....37.00**  
Deep morello-cherry red with violet hues, black fruit, liquorice and subtle mineral notes, cocoa and tasty notes from barrel ageing, supple and balanced with a refreshing finish.

**Colonial Estate Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia, 2017 .....37.00**  
The Explorateur Shiraz offers sweet aromas of blackberries, white pepper, liquorice and graphite. Full-bodied, powerful and rich.

**Brouilly Domaine des Dames de la Roche, Jean Loron, Burgundy, France, 2017 .....39.00**  
This beautiful 12th-century property lies in the heart of the appellation. The seven hectares of vines with an average age of 45 years are planted on granite soils that suit the Gamay grape well. Classically vibrant summer-fruit bouquet with a typically light ripe, juicy palate.

**Rolland & Gal Ribera del Duero, Castilla - Leon, Spain, 2015 .....50.00**  
The wine is aged in French oak barrels for about 10 months before final blending; about 15% of the blend is Merlot, which adds colour and flavour complexity. Aromas of cinnamon, lavender, and black cherry lead to a smooth-textured, concentrated and fleshy palate that shows elegance and silky tannins.

**Big Max Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, California, USA, 2017 .....52.00**  
Named after the last known brown bear in Northern California in the 60s. It has a big, bold taste that pairs perfectly with a juicy steak or bowl of pasta with a hearty red meat sauce. Aromas of smokey toasty spice from the year in oak and powerful rich layers of cherry and dark berries on the palate. The finish is long and lingering.

### Make It Interesting

**Undurruga Merlot, Central Valley, Chile, 2016 .....30.00**  
The 'U by Undurruga' Merlot has a ruby red colour with violet tones. Well balanced with medium body which makes it perfect with pasta, white meats and mild cheese.

**Undurruga Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile, 2017 ..... 31.00**  
Elegantly perfumed aroma. Fresh and very floral on the palate. Recommended as an aperitif although it can easily accompany fish, seafood and oriental dishes.

**Luis Felipe Edwards Reserva Pinot Noir, Maule Valley, Chile, 2017..... 31.00**  
This is a very expressive Pinot Noir; ripe and bursting with redcurrants, strawberry and mulberry. It also has a small amount of spice and a hint of vanilla from the short period of time spent in oak.

**Pablo Old Vine Garnacha, Aragon, Spain, 2017 .....32.00**  
Garnacha has been the mainstay of wine production in the mountainous Calatayud region for hundreds of years. The grapes for this richly flavoured wine were hand-harvested from bush-trained vines, many of which are about 100 years old, grown in vineyards up to 800 metres above sea level. Shows ripe blueberry, blackberry and cherry fruit backed by a refreshing juicy finish.

**Strofilia Mountain Fish Agiorgitiko Dry Red, Peloponnese, Greece, 2015.....34.00**  
The nose shows notes of wild cherry and red fruits, whilst the palate is smooth, aromatic with a velvety finish punctuated by clove and vanilla spice. The wine is named after the 'mountain fish' that live in the stream that flows past the vineyards.

**Feudi Salentini 125 Negroamaro del Salento, Puglia, Italy, 2016.....37.00**  
This wine is ruby-red with purple hints and it has intense fragrances of wild berries, in particular mulberry and blueberry. On the palate, persistent fruity notes stand out, alongside a distinctive bitter note on the velvety finish.

**Quinta do Vallado Douro Tinto, Portugal 2017.....38.00**  
Rich, damson flavours, with a great structure. A modern take on a classic blend of Portuguese grapes, it is a rich, brambly wine.



- Rimat Moli Cabernet Sauvignon Costers del Segre, Catalunya, Spain 2015 .....38.00**  
Powerfully aromatic, with dominating primary notes of forest berries and plums intermingling with balsamic, liquorice, vanilla and coffee notes, benefiting from well-integrated wood, giving a toasty, cocoa background. Elegant and full-bodied, with velvety tannins to provide a good structure and a long finish.
- Weingut Winter Pinot Noir Trocken VDP. Gutswein, Rheinhessen, Germany, 2016 .....42.00**  
The grapes are grown around Dittelsheim on profound and limey soils. The grapes are picked by hand and fermented for 21 days, then aged for 14 months in oak. Elegant juiciness and finesse characterise this Pinot Noir. Its balanced acidity combining with delicate tannins help with the enjoyed length and drinkability of the wine
- Salentein Barrel Selection Malbec, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina, 2014 .....45.00**  
Deep red-purple coloured wine, very intense nose with notes of ripe blackberry, blueberry and redcurrant, with subtle hints of violet. The silky palate has a crisp, balancing acidity which shows the fruit and floral notes backed by vanilla on the lingering finish. Barrel-aged for about a year in a mixture of new and seasoned French oak barrels prior to bottling.
- Nederberg Motorcycle Marvel, Western Cape, South Africa, 2016 ..... 45.00**  
Winemaker at Nederburg for 33 years, Günter Brözel used his 250cc BSA motorcycle to take him quickly around the estate – he demanded exceptionally high standards! A blend of Grenache, Carignan, Shiraz, Mourvèdre and Cinsault (31%, 31%, 18%, 11% and 9% respectively) all hand-harvested. Fermented in open-topped tanks, the wine was matured in barrels, some French oak and none new, for about two years prior to bottling. Spicy hedgerow fruit on the nose, the palate is rich and intense with silky tannins.
- Montepulciano d’Abruzzo, Organic, Torre dei Beati, Abruzzo , Italy, 2016 ..... 49.00**  
Fermentation takes place in steel vats, with a cold pre-maceration and a total maceration of 20 days, the wine is then aged for 12 months, half in 3,000 litre Slovenian oak casks, half in second-use French oak barriques. Shows complex fruit, lightly enriched by spicy notes and not overwhelmed by the wood ageing. Firm-bodied and smooth, balanced by the fine tannins, which, in combination with the natural minerality and the well measured acidity, contribute to a good finish.
- Garage Wine Co Perverso NV, Maule Valley, Chile, NV .....50.00**  
This wine is full-bodied, but with soft red and black fruit flavours and some minty and spicy notes.
- Glatzer Blaufrankisch Reserve, Carnunum, Austria, 2014 .....55.00**  
Robust, spicy red with a firm tannin structure and aromas of blackberries and violets, paired with an elegant herbal note.
- Veralda Refosco Istria, Croatia, 2015 .....45.00**  
Deep and bright with ripe red and black fruit aromas, and subtle hints of vanilla and clove. The palate boasts a huge, spicy, tannic structure yet also an extremely harmonious core of sloe, elderberry and black-and-redcurrant fruit. Long, vibrant and youthful, with an intense and chewy, fresh finish.



## Make It Special

- Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Nicolis, Italy, 2012 .....70.00**  
This is a big rich wine with deep concentrated dried fruit, chocolate, spice and plum flavours. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity balance the intensity of flavour.
- Barolo Castiglione, Viette, Piedimont, Italy, 2012 .....90.00**  
Sweet red berries, freshly cut flowers, spices and mint are some of the many notes that grace the palate in a young Barolo with extraordinary finesse.
- Châteauneuf du Pape, Château de Beaucastel, Rhone, France, 2008 .....120.00**  
This vintage is very bright ruby in appearance; a beautiful wine with power intense aromas of black fruit and chocolate. A vibrant wine with great balance.
- Morey-St-Denis 1er Cru Chaffots, Burgundy, France, 2010 .....130.00**  
Chaffots sits just above Grand Cru Clos de la Roche on the very rocky terrain with not much top soil. There are some nice whole bunch aromatics going on here and more flesh than a Chaffots sometimes shows at this stage. If this continues to go in the right direction, it could be a little cracker.
- Catena Zapata, Atena Zapata, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2013 .....140.00**  
Packed with generous flavours of ripe red fruit and spices, this is a vibrant, full bodied intense Malbec. This vineyard (at 1,600 metres above sea level is one of the highest in the Uco Valley) delivers intense freshness and crisp acidity.
- Château Lagrange St Julien, Bordeaux, France, 2011.....150.00**  
Concentrated, structured, tannic, firm and built to age, this powerful, masculine St Julien is still young. Time and effort were needed before the earthy, coffee, blackberry, fresh herb and tobacco personality began to emerge. This demands at least 5-8 years in the cellar for everything to come together.
